



Legacy Provision Review Guidelines and Checklist

Guideline to Candidates for Design Selection

Applicants are expected to present landscape designs of residential and commercial projects that:

- They played a primary role in creating
- Clearly demonstrate their level of professional competency
- Contain detailed grading, drainage, construction and layout plans, etc.
- Include before and after photos of the project

Review Guidelines

Reviewers will assess presentations to determine whether the applicant has a level of competency equivalent to or higher than that established by the regular CLD certification program.

Process Guidelines

- a) There will be a minimum of two reviewers per applicant.
- b) Reviewers cannot also be the applicant's sponsors.
- c) Application and sponsor forms will be reviewed to determine applicants' suitability to apply under the legacy provision.
- d) Upon approving an application to proceed under the provision, applicants will be invited to present their designs (see presentation guidelines) for review.
- e) Reviews can occur electronically whereby submissions are emailed to reviewers who complete the review by email correspondence without having a meeting.
- f) When reviewers require a meeting to review applications and/or presentations, the CNLA staff person will make the arrangements and may explore the possibility of virtual meetings.
- g) The CNLA staff person will provide reviewers with applicants' presentations in a timely manner.
- h) An interview with the applicant may occur at the reviewers' discretion.
- i) When an interview is required, the CNLA staff person will, in collaboration with the reviewers and applicant, determine a suitable method for the interview. Electronic conferencing options may be considered.
- j) Applicants will have a maximum of two years to submit updated portfolios addressing reviewers' comments/requests to provide additional or supplemental information.





Portfolio Submission Checklist for Legacy Provision Applicants

- Elevation information

- o Design quality & aesthetics
- o Design criteria
